PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the motion. The question is: Shall Senator Stahmer be allowed to withdraw LB 671. All those in favor of that motion will vote aye, all those opposed will vote no. The motion is to withdraw LB 671, Senator Stahmer's request. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 33 ayes, no nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 671 is withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, there is now pending a report from the Committee on Committees by Senator Whitney. The report is set out in full on page 417 recommending to the Legislature the confirmation of the appointment by Governor Exon of G. William Burrows to the Advisory Committee of Public Welfare and Public Institutions, Stanley Matzke to the Director Department of Administrative Services and James Jackson, Director Department of Insurance.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Whitney.

SENATOR WHITNEY: Mr. President I ask unanimous consent that all three persons be voted on at the same time because there is no opposing votes at all. All thirteen members of the Committee on Committees was there and voted favorably on each one of these persons. Mr. Burrows, Mr. Matzke, and Mr. Jackson. So I ask unanimous consent that we vote on all three at the same time.

PRESIDENT: Are there objections to considering the three appointments in one vote. Any objections? Hearing none. So ordered. Then we will proceed with one vote for the confirmation of the three. Go ahead Senator Whitney.

SENATOR WHITNEY: I move that these three appointments by the Governor be confirmed by the Legislative body. Mr. G. William Burrows, to the Advisory Committee of Public Welfare and Public Institutions, Mr. Stanley A. Matzke, Director Department of Administrative Services, and Mr. James M. Jackson, Director Department of Insurance.

PRESIDENT: Is there any further discussion of the motion? The question is then, shall these three appointments be confirmed. All those in favor will vote aye, all those opposed will vote no. You are voting on the confirmation of the three appointments as explained by Senator Whitney. Voting on the confirmation of the appointments. Once again the Chair would inquire, have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 43 ayes, no nays, 6 not voting ( recorded in Journal on page 443)

PRESIDENT: The appointments are confirmed. Do we have other..

CLERK: Mr. President, I move that LB 651 be advanced to General File notwithstanding the action of the Committee. (Signed) Senator Waldron. He has indicated that he would like to lay the motion over.
