

PRESIDENT: Question. Senator Skarda.

SENATOR SKARDA: Mr. President, members, I certainly don't want to stand up and pick on my colleague and Senator that represents the same area that I do. You are talking about \$11,000 or \$12,000 it doesn't seem very much to me, when we talking about saving it seems to me that in the World Hearld that it exposed in a series of articles these SID's and what they ~~are~~ doing we are putting ourselves right back in the hole again and I think of avoiding the notification and these people should get properly. I think that we have got a bad piece of legislation. I am just concerned about it and I'm afraid that I'm going to have to vote against it. I'm just speaking as one of the members of the Douglas County delegation.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the bill? Question is shall LB655 be advanced from General File to E & R Initial? All those opposed vot no. You are voting on the advancement of LB655 from General File. Have you all voted? Senator Goodrich.

SENATOR GOODRICH: I need about five more votes to advance the bill. I don't want to have a call of the house.

PRESIDENT: Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 2 nays Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Bill is advanced. This brings up for General File discussion then LB334, Senator Cavanaugh's bill.

CLERK: Read LB334, I don't think that Senator Cavanaugh ever showed up Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Cavanaugh in the chamber? Pass the bill, move on the 653, Senator Goodrich's bill.

CLERK: Read LB653

PRESIDENT: Senator Cavanaugh is not here to handle his motion, Senator Chambers did you wish to be recognized on this bill?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, if I may be permitted to do so, I think that I can deal with Senator Cavanaugh's amendment.

PRESIDENT: Go ahead.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: We have discussed this bill thoroughly prior to its being laid over. I opposed the motion to lay it over, because at that time, the discussion would have been clear still in everybody's mind. Now it may be necessary to rehearse a few things, so I will be very brief in doing so. The purpose of the amendment and the ultimate purpose of the bill would be to insure that whenever property is acquired by a public agency, for public use, regardless of how it is required there will be a necessity for notice and a public hearing. A couple of the elements that should be considered in the acquisition of property is not only the agreement between the buyer and the seller but of those people that might have a joining or budding or nearby property because perhaps the use that would be made of the property by the
