PRESIDENT: Will the Legislature please come to order. We will have prayer by Chaplain Palmer.

CHAPLAIN: Prayer given.

PRESIDENT: Roll call.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Anderson asked to be excused today and tomorrow. Senator Richard Lewis asked to be excused from 10:30 on today and tomorrow. And Senator Frank Lewis asked to excused until he arrives.

PRESIDENT: Are there objections. Hearing none. It is so ordered then. Please indicate your presence. Clerk will record. Is there a quorum present?

CLERK: Well, not so far.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. The Legislature will be at ease. There is not a quorum present.

CLERK: Quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: All right, we finally have a quorum. Are there corrections for the Journal? Are there corrections for the Journal?
