CLERK: 33 ayes Mr. President on the motion to introduce.

PRESIDENT: The rules are suspended and the bills will be introduced, Clerk will read the titles.

CLERK: (Read LB1011, LB1012, LB1013, LB1014.) That is all Mr. President on that. Mr. President, we have pending a motion by Senator Snyder to withdraw LB477, the motion was first considered on Friday and laid over.

PRESIDENT: Motion to be laid over.

CLERK: No it was laid over Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Excuse me, I am sorry, bring it up. Senator Nore, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR NORE: Mr. President, a point of information. I thought that we were voting on suspension of the rules and not introducing bills the last time around.

PRESIDENT: I am sorry if the Chair didn't make that clear but the motion was to suspend the rules and introduce the four bills.

SENATOR NORE: And introduce the four bills?

PRESIDENT: Yes, only for the sake of saving time.

SENATOR NORE: As a point of personal privilege, I certainly agree with Senator Carpenter. I have no grievances for the Governor, I think he is a good Governor, but the head of the Banking department serves under the Governor's pleasure and I think that sending the bill over here and getting 30 pigeons to put their name on it instead of him, I think that he should put his name on the bill.

PRESIDENT: Thank you Senator Nore. We have Senator Carpenters' motion, which we will debate after we take up Select File and move on down to other pending motions. Senator Snyder, are you ready for your motion on 467?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Snyder asked to take no action on that.

PRESIDENT: Alright, by pass that. The Chair was mistaken, it wasn't 467, it was LB702, and he has asked now to lay that motion over again. Alright we move to consideration of bills now on Select File. Senator Cavanaugh? Yes, Senator Carpenter we are going to take it up in a minute, just as soon as we clear up Select File, it would be in proper order then. Senator Cavanaugh?

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Can I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB592?

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion to move the E & R amendments to LB592, all those in favor of the motion say aye, those opposed say no? Thank you the amendments are adopted.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move LB592 as amended be moved to E & R for engrossing.
