on Select File. All those in favor say aye, those opposed say no. So ordered. The amendments are then struck. Now, then is there further action on 762? Mr. Clerk, any further amendments or action on 762?

SENATOR CLARK: Now, the Emergency Clause has been added.

PRESIDENT: That's correct.

SENATOR CLARK: OK, I move that 762...

PRESIDENT: Standby for just a moment. Senator Marsh for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR MARSH: I have a question please. When we are removing them on Select File, is this a voice vote or is this supposed to be a machine vote?

PRESIDENT: Well, it probably should be a machine vote and the Chair would stand corrected on that particular motion.

SENATOR MARSH: I understand it takes 25 votes.

PRESIDENT: Well, at the same time the E & R Amendments were added by voice vote, the Chair assumes you could take them off by voice vote. If you want a machine vote, so ordered and it will be done. The question is do you want to remove...Senator Whitney for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR WHITNEY: Mr. President I do not understand the motion. Is it to remove the E & R Amendments and the Carpenter Amendment?

PRESIDENT: They are one and the same, Senator Whitney.

SENATOR WHITNEY: Yes, then I am quite certain it takes 25 votes to do that.

PRESIDENT: Alright, question is do you want to remove the E & R Amendments, strike the E & R Amendments, which in essence is the Carpenter Amendment to 762 on Select File. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. This is the motion to remove the E & R Amendments which are the same as the Carpenter Amendments to 762 on Select File. Thank you, the Clerk will record.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: OK, now the amendments are struck. Now we move the bill on.

SENATOR CLARK: I move that 762 as amended by advanced to E & R for Engrossing.

PRESIDENT: The motion now is to advance 762 as amended, all those in favor of advancing the bill say aye, those opposed say no. Bill is advanced.

SENATOR CLARK: I move the E & R Amendments to 806 be adopted.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion to adopt the E & R Amendments to 806. All those in favor of the motion, say aye, those opposed say no. So ordered, the amendments are adopted.
