PRESIDENT: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Would Senator Snyder yield to a question?

SENATOR SNYDER: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Snyder, currently would there have to be any change in the law to allow Podiatrists to possess the substance that the anesthetic would be composed of. In other words, and can they legally possess the substance they use as an anesthetic?

SENATOR SNYDER: Senator, I have absolutely no idea.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: O.K. I was just curious.

SENATOR SNYDER: You might ask, if anyone that does. I do not. I don't know.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of LB778? If not, Senator Snyder, do you care to close? No closing? Those in favor of LB778, will vote aye. Those opposed will vote nay. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 29 ayes, Mr. President, to advance.

PRESIDENT: LB778 is advanced to E & R initial. The next bill is LB632.

CLERK: LB632 read. There are no committee amendments. There is a committee amendment. There's a request by Senator Carpenter to hold the bill until Tuesday. And, I assume that this is the amendment. And there is a 25-page amendment by Senator Carpenter.

PRESIDENT: While we are waiting. Senator Luedtke's asked to be excused for the balance of the morning. Are there any objections? If not, so ordered.

CLERK: LB632, right.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: This is a highly controversial amendment. It's been printed in the Journal, I think, the substance of the bill. And I would hope that I'd be permitted to pass the bill over. Not because I'm not ready to take it up, because I am. Now what the bill says--it's going to give them the \$10.00 or \$12.00 every year. We just eliminate the tax on the sales tax on food. A year or so ago, I was opposed to it. And like I generally am, I've changed my mind. And, I think we ought to do.....
