tried to define this, but not to be confusing, and we've had some difficulty about this, and the amendment that I have sent up which I am now asking to be submitted in lieu of the committee amendment is, has the best conceivable definition to put into language what we're attempting to do. And that is simply that all inheritance taxes shall cease to be liens 10 years from the date of death of the decedent. Unless action has been taken in the meantime to have the inheritance taxes determined in the County Court. Now, this in essence is the bill. It is fair and it is reasonable, and it clears up a problem that we had last year.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to reject the committee amendment. Which shall take a voice vote. Those in favor say aye, those opposed say nay. Motion carries. We are ready for the Carstens amendment

SENATOR CARSTENS: I move for the adoption of the amendment which I have sent up to the Clerk's desk. The one I've just explained.

PRESIDENT: Any discussion. Anybody care to have it read? It has been explained. Do you care to close Senator Carstens?

SENATOR CARSTENS: No, I do not.

PRESIDENT: Those in favor. We will take a voice vote. Those in favor of the Carstens amendment say aye. Those opposed say nay. The motion carries. Anymore amendments.

SENATOR CARSTENS: Yes, the emergency clause is the other one isn't it?

CLERK: I have no more. You rejected the committee amendment which included the emergency clause. Do you want to put that back on.

SENATOR CARSTENS: I want to put the emergency clause back on.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to add the emergency clause to LB 664. Any discussion. Those in favor say aye. Those opposed say nay. The emergency clause is added. Do you wish any further discussion of the bill, Senator Carstens?

SENATOR CARSTENS: No, I move that the bill be advanced to E & R for Initial.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to advance LB 664 to E & R Initial. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote nay. Senator Whitney voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Whitney voting aye.

PRESIDENT: Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The bill advances. The next bill is LB 666.

CLERK: LB 666 (read) There are committee amendments.
