PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Stull for his amendments.

SENATOR STULL: Mr. President and members of the Legislature. I move the adoption of the committee amendments and as the bill was introduced, the termination of the lien of Real Estate for unpaid judgements and court costs would have been 10 years and the committee amendments reduces that down to 5 years and adds the emergency clause.

PRESIDENT: The question is shall the committee amendments be adopted. Will all those in favor please say aye. Those opposed say no. So ordered. The committee amendments are adopted. Back to you Senator Fred Carstens.

SENATOR FRED CARSTENS: I move the bill be advanced to E & R Initial. Mr. President and members of the Legislature. This is a similar bill to the one we just discussed previously. Which dealt with inheritance tax lien. This is a bill to clear up the title of Real Estate where unpaid court costs which have lingered on for years and years appear. And you can't find out and you can't find out or locate the people who owe the court costs and have always creates a problem in the matter of titles. This puts a limitation..a statute of limitation to 5 years on unpaid court costs. And this is reasonable and proper and should have been adopted long ago. I move for the bill to be advance.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the bill. Then the question is, if there is no further discussion. Shall LB 666 be advanced from general file to E & R Initial. All those in favor will vote aye, all those opposed will vote no. You are voting on the advancement of LB 666 from general file to E & R Initial. The Chair needs to remind you that still takes 25 votes. Thank you. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, no nays, Mr. President on motion to advance.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced.

CLERK: Mr. President, 670 comes up next. There is a request to bracket the bill by Senator Luedtke.

PRESIDENT: Are there objections to bracketing the bill. Hearing none. So ordered. We will bracket the bill 670. Pass on then to LB 683.

CLERK: LB 683 (read) There are committee amendments by Senator Luedtke's Judiciary Committee.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Stull.

SENATOR STULL: Mr. President and members of the Legislature. Senator Fellman will handle this bill and also the amendments.

PRESIDENT: Also the amendments, Thank you. The Chair recognizes then, Senator Fellman, FOR THE Amendments.

SENATOR FELLMAN: Mr. President, I have to read these amendments over, I'm not sure what the amendments say.

PRESIDENT: All right, stand by.

SENATOR FELLMAN: Do you want to take the next bill and come back to it?
