PRESIDENT: Gentlemen, the Chair find itself between a rock and a hard place in that we have a motion to adjourn at this particular time, and the Chair is also mindful that at 1:00 this afternoon you have an important meeting coming up and we do have some things that have to be read into the record. So Senator Cavanaugh may I ask that you yield the floor please, to the motion to adjourn.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: I would certainly do that.

PRESIDENT: Thank you.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a series of things that need to be read in, one is a letter from the Secretary of State (read)

Mr. President, Senator Skarda asked to be excused on Friday. Senator Cavanaugh asked to be excused tomorrow. Mr. President, the Revenue Committee Reference.

PRESIDENT: Are there objections to their absences? Hearing none. So ordered.

CLERK: Reference Report (Signed) Senator Carpenter  
Mr. President, Senator Carpenter requests unanimous consent to switch LB 995 from Labor to Government and LB 329 from Judiciary to Government Committee (Signed) Senator Carpenter.

PRESIDENT: Was that unanimous consent.

CLERK: Yes.

PRESIDENT: Are there objections to switching any of those bills from those committees that were scheduled. Are there objections? Hearing none. So ordered then. They can be moved.

CLERK: Mr. President, Labor Committee has set bills for hearing (Signed) Senator Maresh, Chairman.  
Mr. President, your committee on Constitutional Revision to whom was referred LB 779 instructs me to report same legislation be advanced to General File as amended (Signed) Senator Syas.  
Mr. President, a unanimous consent to bracket 632 which we had earlier bracketed on the 13 to the 19th (Signed) Senator Maresh

PRESIDENT: Are there objections to bracketing the bill until the 19th. Senator Maresh for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR MARESH: Mr. President, I move to the Legislature, my motion is to send it back to committee. Unbracket this bill and send it back to committee hearing on February 19.
