SENATOR SNYDER: Fine, Mr. President the statement of intents were passed out yesterday. I had a couple of questions but they were passed out yesterday, we just didn't get to them. I would ask for suspension of the rules to introduce the four committee bills.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Only as a suggestion, these are only bills, they are not laws, why would we have to...I am... like the rest of us, why do we introduce a bill immediately and quit talking about them, if they get out of the committee and get on the floor that is the time to take ahold of the subject and do what you can do with the bill. I would hope that we would introduce the bills that have the recommendation of the committee without a lot of oratory and a lot of debate that really doesn't mean anything. Because we can get the bills in and out quickly and we can debate them on the floor without having anything before us. I would hope that the legislature and I don't want to be objectionable, lets introduce the bill, we have got this school aid bill which is one of the most important bills before the body this year. I hope that we would introduce the bills and get on this subject and lets dispose of it one way or the other.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the motion? Question is shall the rules be suspended and introduce the four bills. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote not.
