

PRESIDENT: Bill is introduced. Do you want to read the title then?

CLERK: Read request number 1571.

PRESIDENT: Senator Cavanaugh do you want to amend your motion to just introduce the bill. OK, thank you. Senator Cavanaugh.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, this is more or less a companion bill to the bill introduced by Senator Anderson for constitution revision. It is an alternate way to redistrict the court. Senator Anderson's bill would do it by constitutional amendment providing for three districts where you would have two justices serving from each district. This would maintain the six districts but would realign their geographic boundaries so we would have a choice as to which way we would want to do it.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the motion? Then the question is, shall the bill be introduced as explained by Senator Cavanaugh. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Voting on the introduction of the bill by Senator Cavanaugh. As explained by Senator Cavanaugh. Once again, have you all voted? Thank you, Clerk will record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays and 19 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill is introduced.

CLERK: Read LB1030, LB1031, LB1032, LB1033. That is all Mr. President. Read Committee reports. Read enrollment and review report regarding LB730, LB77A, LB17A, LB684, LB772, LB827. LB796. That is all Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Any other bills for introduction then?

CLERK: None.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. We are ready for the consideration of bills on Select File. Chair recognizes Senator Cavanaugh.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I would move that LB613 be laid over for a day. I am still attempting to get a fiscal impact from the tax commissioner on that and I... Senator Carpenter agrees to that I believe.

PRESIDENT: Can we take the E & R amendments to it first Senator Cavanaugh?

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: OK, I move the E & R amendments to LB613 be adopted.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to adopt the E & R amendments to LB613 on Select File. All those in favor of the motion say aye, those opposed say no. Ayes have it we are adopting the E & R amendments. Now, Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I would like to ask that 613 be held until tomorrow. Senator Cavanaugh is asking for an A bill and it apparently won't be ready until tomorrow.
