SENATOR STAHMER: Alright, with that in mind, I'm going to object then, because I don't think we gain anything and I think it's a disservice perhaps, I'm not sure, to the people outstate that they wouldn't otherwise have adequate notification of the bills in their Final Form. Let's get on with Select File and General File.

PRESIDENT: Senator Stahmer, the Chair was trying to reach you to talk about that, Senator. The reason I asked was that you see Senator Carpenter had withdrawn both of his motions and the motion was shall Senator Carpenter, by unanimous consent, be allowed to withdraw both of his motions which would leave the Board on Final Reading just as it is. Are you objecting...

SENATOR STAHMER: Pardon my confusion, I should have come five minutes later.

PRESIDENT: I'm sorry Senator Stahmer, alright, very good. Then if there are no objections to the withdrawal of Senator Carpenter's two motions, then they are withdrawn and we will proceed with Final Reading as is usual.

CLERK: Mr. President, just ahead of Final Reading we have Opinions from the Attorney General's Office addressed to Senator Gary Anderson, addressed to Senator George Syas, and addressed to Senator Nore. These will be set in full in the Journal

PRESIDENT: So ordered. Well, we would like to clear the floor and get the Senators in their seats for Final Reading here, please.

PRESIDENT: Once again the Chair would like to diplomatically, at least, ask the members to get in their seats so that we can begin Final Reading.

CLERK: Mr. President, just ahead of Final Reading I have some reports I can read. Your committee on Agriculture has referred LB916 instructs me to report the same has been indefinitely postponed 887 General File, 934 General File as amended, 935 General File; signed Senator Schmit, Chairman. And also a notice of Committee Hearing setting a bill for hearing on February 21 at 2:00.

PRESIDENT: OK, looks like we're ready for the Final Reading of LB323 attention please. Clerk will read the bill.

CLERK: LB323 read.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, Shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Once again, have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: Votes printed on page 601 of Journal. 35 ayes, 10 nays, 4 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill is passed. Attention please.

CLERK: Mr. President, I move to return LB513 to Select File for specific amendments, signed Senator Goodrich.
