PRESIDENT: Wait Senator Duis, what amendment are you discussing? Is this the Maresh amendment?

SENATOR DUIS: No, he has withdrawn his amendment.

PRESIDENT: No, he only withdrew it on the basis that Senator Carpenter would withdraw his. We still have before the body the Maresh amendment.

SENATOR DUIS: I am withdrawing the part of the amendment that he has reference to. He understands this.

PRESIDENT: O.K., you are now withdrawing the part of the Carpenter amendment that has to....

SENATOR DUIS: That has to do with the limitation of spending. I said that I would amend that to only include on page 23 after line 16 to insert which is the intent of the Legislature that there will be appropriated 55 million dollars to the first year and 120 million after the year to fund the bill. That is what we are voting on.

PRESIDENT: Alright Senator Maresh? It is my understanding now that Senator Maresh is withdrawing his amendment. Is that correct? With the understanding now that he is allowed to withdraw that section or to strike that section of the original amendment, is that correct? Alright, then at this time we have the Duis, Senator Duis is withdrawing, Senator Maresh has withdrawn his motion, Senator Duis is amending the original motion now and the original amendment which is, as the Chair understands it, is the rest of page 508 and 509. Is that correct Senator Duis? Is this the amendment that appears on page 508 and 509?

SENATOR DUIS: It is that last part of it that has to do with the funding of it, that is all that we are voting on.

PRESIDENT: Correct then you are attempting to amend that by striking part of it, correct? Trying to withdraw all of it? All page 508 and 509? Excuse me, the rest, all but paragraph 3?

SENATOR DUIS: Right.

PRESIDENT: O.K. Are there objections? Senator Lewis?

SENATOR FRANK LEWIS: I have a question for Senator Duis. In the placement of the amendment, now that would be placed after a provision of the bill that provides for setting of limits. Why would that particular, why place it in that particular section?

SENATOR DUIS: We are taking out of this amendment all of those of that part that has to do with limitation and all we are leaving in the amendment right now to be adopted this morning is the funding of the bill which is 55 million the first year and 120 million the second. In the Carpenter amendment. You have to look at page 508 of your.
