PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, Shall the bill pass? All those in favor will vote aye, all those opposed will vote no. And again the Chair would inquire have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: Votes on page 621 of the Legislative Journal. 48 ayes, 0 nays, 1 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill is passed. Are there resolutions on the desk?

CLERK: None.

PRESIDENT: Do we have any bills for introduction?

CLERK: None.

PRESIDENT: We're ready then for the consideration of the bills on Select File. Senator Carpenter?

CLERK: Mr. President, there is a request to bracket LB772 on Select File.

PRESIDENT: Senator Warner?

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, the reason that I offer the bracket, I spoke to some of you this morning as I had an opportunity indicating that I was going to make the motion to strike the amendments that were attached yesterday because there are some rather technical problems with the trying to fit the two bills...or the two concepts together later with the discussion with Senator Carpenter, who offered the amendments and Senator Duis. They, if I'm speaking correctly, concurred that they would agree if the body agrees that I would attempt to draw some amendments which would properly fit with 772 that would have the concept that they spoke of as 50-50 split between foundation equalization as opposed to the 60-40 that is in the bill. And in order to provide, well I see no point in spending time going through the arguments that justify the striking of the present amendment since they agree if we can redraft one that is accurate to reflect intent with the bill that it can be discussed at that point which I think would save time all around if we do that, and I would assume we could have the amendments ready tomorrow if the body wants to take it up tomorrow.

PRESIDENT: Now, let's make sure the Chair did not hear anything beyond just the motion to bracket the bill. You are opposing that we...

SENATOR WARNER: I explained why, but that's all I'm asking.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Alright now, the motion is just to bracket 772 on Select File. Is there any further discussion of that motion? Are there any objections to bracketing 772 on Select File as moved by Senator Warner? Any objections? Hearing none, so ordered then, the bill is bracketed then on Select File. That moves us in to the Select File consideration of 697. Senator Cavanaugh?

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move the adoption of E & R amendments on LB697.
