

SENATOR NORE: Mr. President and fellow members, I would advise you to be here on Friday because this is a day that the sleepers go by.

PRESIDENT: I am sorry. This is the day what?

SENATOR NORE: This is the day that the sleeper bills get by.

PRESIDENT: (laughter) O.K. Any other discussion of the motion? Question is, shall the motion be adopted? All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. You are voting on the motion to hear the non-controversial bills Friday. Thank you, Clerk will record.

CLERK: 29 ayes, no nays.

PRESIDENT: Thank you, the motion carries and it will be so ordered. Now before we move to finishing, Senator Simpson? Senator Simpson, we are going to move back to 293 because that is unfinished business here that actually comes up and we would like to move that out of the way here before we go onto General File and so, I should have said impossible but would you yield the floor for just a moment please for just a couple of introductions? We are very privileged this morning to have 30 students here from Shelton High School, Shelton, Nebraska and it looks like it is Mrs. Nick Keller is the instructor, they are from Senator Stromer's district and we are delighted to have them here along with 18 students from the ninth grade at junior high school of Columbus, Nebraska. They are from Senator Nore's district, they are all in the north balcony. The instructors are Richard Chamberlain and it looks like Dan Holsher and Clem Morgan and we are very glad to have you here today as visitors to the Nebraska Unicameral Legislature, this is where the action is and you are going to hear some good debate in just a little bit here on General File, this is where you really get down to discussing the fine points of legislation. We are pleased to have you here as visitors. Now, Senator Simpson, let's have the Clerk bring us up to date on 293. Incidentally, to the visitors if you watch the board up here you can tell the number up behind me that is the number of the bill that is being debated and generally follow along as to what is going on. Senator Simpson? Wait a minute, the Clerk please bring us up to date?

CLERK: Mr. President, all amendments pending on LB293 have been adopted with the exception of one that has been offered by Senator Chambers. It would amend the Goodrich amendment, page 14, line 9 after "comply", add "after written or actual notice" same in the amendment lines 19 and 20. Signed Senator Chambers.

PRESIDENT: Alright, back to you Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President and members of the Legislature. This is an amendment which the last time we debated the bill, was offered and voted down because there was some misunderstanding about exactly what the amendment did. So rather than striking any words, the words written note that this merely adds or actual notice and it has been agreed to by Senator Simpson, who would first objected, and since it has been agreed to by Senator Goodrich whose amendment this is an amendment of so I ask that you adopt this one.

PRESIDENT: Alright, is there any further discussion of the Chambers amendment to the Goodrich amendment to 293? Any further discussion? The question is then shall the Chambers amendment be adopted? All those in favor please say aye, those opposed please say no. Ayes have it, so ordered, the amendment is adopted. Then are there other amendments now to the Goodrich amendment? Vince? Alright, Senator Simpson, back to you then.
