

PRESIDENT: Senator Waldron.

SENATOR WALDRON: I talked with Senator Kremer and he has agreed that we can exchange committee hearing rooms between the Miscellaneous Subjects and Public Works again this Thursday because we will have a large number at the miscellaneous committee and he seems to be satisfied with the public works downstairs. I would just like to ask unanimous consent that that be done.

PRESIDENT: Any objections? Hearing none, so ordered.

CLERK: Read Senator Murphys unanimous request to print amendments in the Journal.

PRESIDENT: Senator Syas.

SENATOR SYAS: Isn't there a bill up there to be introduced?

CLERK: We have one from Miscellaneous Subjects, yes.

SENATOR SYAS: I thought that there was one from budget. Senator Marvel.

PRESIDENT: Senator Marvel.

SENATOR SYAS: I was asking about that bill that has to be put or pushed along. Is that up there?

PRESIDENT: Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: I think that there is an introducers statement on your desk in regards to an emergency for the construction of the school of the deaf in the amount of \$140,000 that this is not acted upon by the first of March the cost will probably go up so we requested the introduction of the bill which would add \$140,000 to the original building request. I so move that the bill be introduced.

PRESIDENT: Any more discussion of the bill? Question is then shall the bill be introduced? All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. 30 votes are required. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays and 19 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill is introduced.

CLERK: Read 1036.

PRESIDENT: Is there any other business to come before the body?

CLERK: I have none. I move that we adjourn until 9:00 signed Senator Stahmer.

PRESIDENT: All in favor of adjournment will say aye, those opposed no. Ayes have it we are adjourned.
