If he is agreeing to let this amendment be passed, I agree 100%. No other amendment but the one that is printed in the book here of Tuesday so that we all agree that when we come back that it will be constructed the way we want it. I'm just asking that we put the one amendment that is now printed in the book. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion now of the motion? Question is shall LB513 be returned to Select File for the specific amendment. All those in favor of returning the bill vote aye, those opposed vote no. You heard the explanation on the bill. Question is shall it be returned to Select File. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 37 ayes, Mr. President on the motion to return.

PRESIDENT: OK, the bill is returned.

CLERK: That is all on Final Reading Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. That clears up Final Reading. Are there resolutions on the desk?

CLERK: None.

PRESIDENT: Are there any bills for introduction?

CLERK: Yes, read.

PRESIDENT: Senator Lewis.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Mr. President, I would like to pass over that temporarily, I do not have a letter of intent on the desk, and it would be unfair for me not to have that.

PRESIDENT: OK, thank you. Pass over the motion for the moment.

CLERK: Read Ag Committee request.

PRESIDENT: Senator Schmit, are you ready for your motion?

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, fellow members I would like to ask a Page first to get these explanations around to the members. I'm sorry I don't have them out. I can go ahead and explain the bill. The bill harmonizes the present states law with the federal law of a year ago, the federal government relaxed their provision whereby the state could qualify as a Brucellosis free area and this will bring the thing into compliance with federal regulations and I'm sorry again that I didn't have these explanations out on the desks. I move for the introduction of the bill.

PRESIDENT: Senator Schmit, OK, your explanation of...your statement of intent is on the way, is it?

SENATOR SCHMIT: Yes it is.
