

CLERK: 25 ayes, 1 nay and 23 not voting.

PRESIDENT: Bill is returned. Now, Senator Murphy make your motion.

SENATOR MURPHY: I move to restore the original wording by removing the word greater and restoring the word lesser as agreed by the introducer, myself and several others on the floor.

PRESIDENT: Alright, is there need for further discussion of the motion? Question is a shall the amendment be adopted. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. All those in favor of Senator Murphy's amendment to LB652 on Select File. Thank you. Clerk will record.
