PRESIDENT: Senator Warner, did you want to be recognized?  
Any other announcements on the desk?

CLERK: None.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. We do have some bills on Final Reading this morning. We go to LB 608.  
Senator Luedtke for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Mr. President, I ask unanimous consent to have LB 354 reprinted with all the amendments. That's the uniform probate code, and it has numerous and voluminous amendments and it would be much easier to understand, it will be a while before we get to it, but I wish it would be put out with all the amendments printed in the total bill form with all the amendemnts included.

PRESIDENT: Senator Luedtke asking unanimous consent to reprint LB 354 with all the amendments thereto. Are there objections. Hearing none. So ordered. All right, now hear this while we are attempting to get the Senators in their seats and clear the floor, the Chair has the privilege of introducing a very distinguished visitor we have under the south balcony this morning. I think that the Legislature would want to give a hand for Gail Galbraith, who is seated over there. Gail why don't you step out and let's recognize, Midwestern Assistance Agriculture Director. Once again the Chair would like to advise you we are moving toward final reading and we would like to have you get in the area of approximately their seats and clear the floor. Once again the Chair would like the preogative also of making a special introduction. This is sort of a surprise introduction this morning. Senator Shirley Marsh has just escorted up here beside the Chair a Jean Marsh who is star of the Masterpiece Theater, "Upstairs, Downstairs" series. She is a British Actress, and I think we would want to welcome her this morning. We may even be distant relatives, but anyway I'd like to present Jean Marsh. First bill on Final Reading will be LB 608. I guess I almost blew that introduction, Jean Marsh is a star of our own Education T.V. Masterpiece Theater. "Upstairs Downstairs" series. And therefore, is a participant in our series here in Nebraska. All right, attention please of Final Reading LB 608
