PRESIDENT: Want to pass the amendment up, Senator Barnett?
Senator Barnett.

SENATOR BARNETT:at this time so that we can adopt it.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to reject the committee amendment. All those in favor of rejection of the committee amendment say aye. Those opposed, say no. So ordered, the committee amendment is rejected. Now, Senator Barnett.

SENATOR BARNETT: Mr. President, I'd move that the bill be advanced to E & R initial as amended.

PRESIDENT: All right. The question is that shall LB621 as explained by Senator Barnett and as amended by Senator Barnett be advanced from General File to E & R initial. All those in favor, vote aye. All those opposed, vote no. This is LB621. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, no nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Very good, the bill is advanced.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Carstens has been excused for the next bill.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carstens. Yes, he's passing the bill..... That brings up LB804. Stand by. Senator Carpenter, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR CARPENTER: I'd like to make a suggestion as a point of order.

PRESIDENT: All right.

SENATOR CARPENTER: There are a number of senators who came to me who feel they have bills which are non-controversial which are way down on the list. Now, there could be a difference of opinion but I'd like to say as of 11:30, every senator who has one bill in that category give it to the Clerk with the hope it'll be considered in that order on his desk. Now, does everyone understand what I'm attempting to do? Everybody has bills that they have an interest in and if they're non-controversial, at 11:30, every senator who wants a bill in that category considered puts it on the Clerk's desk, in the order he receives, and then it will consider at that particular time. If noone has any objections.

PRESIDENT: No. Are there any objections to proceeding under that order? Okay. Very good. We'll so do it. I thought there might be some controversial on your bill, Senator Clark, and that was the reason I interrupted. Now, go ahead with the reading of the bill here then.

CLERK: Read LB804. There are no committee amendments, other amendments pending, statements, explanations or anything.

PRESIDENT: Beautiful. Senator Clark, back to you.

SENATOR CLARK: Mr. President, I would move that LB804 be advanced to E & R initial. What this bill does is to increase the money or amount of money the oil and gas commission would get from the oil industry. This has nothing to do with General File. It's a cash agency. It'll raise about \$36,000 for them. It increases the.....I'm getting a lot of input all around me here.
