

PRESIDENT: Is the amendment lengthy? Thank you. All those in favor of adopting committee amendment, please say aye. Those opposed, say no. Committee amendments are adopted. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I move that the bill as amended be advanced to E & R initial.

PRESIDENT: Any need for further discussion of the bill? Then, the question is, shall LB604 be advanced from General File to E & R initial. All those in favor of advancing the bill, vote aye. All those opposed, vote no. Voting on Senator Duis' LB604. Senator Barnett. It should be LB604 on the board. Have you all voted? Once again, have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, no nays.

PRESIDENT: Bill is advanced. Move on to Senator Chambers' LB811.

CLERK: Read LB811. Mr. President, there are voluminous amendments. I have a white copy. I don't know what that is.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: This white copy is the amendment and becomes the bill really.

CLERK: That is the committee amendment?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes.

CLERK: Okay. Then there are committee amendments, Mr. President, by Senator Chambers' Government Committee.

PRESIDENT: All right. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, I move the adoption of these amendments and in explaining the amendment, it will also be an explanation of the bill so I'll do it at once if you don't mind.

PRESIDENT: Fine.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: There were two Supreme Court decisions in June of last year which said that certain licensing and other provisions related to aliens or that would require citizenship to have such a license would be unconstitutional. Nebraska has a long list of these kind of statutes and I worked with the Attorney General on finding all of these provisions in the Nebraska statutes. So, in a sense, this is a reviser of statutes, bills because it eliminates those types of revisions which would be unconstitutional. So, I ask you to adopt the committee amendments because they merely list all of those statutes that would be involved.

CLERK: Mr. President, there are committee amendments and then there's another set of amendments which are not the same.

PRESIDENT: Oh, really.

CLERK: Yeah. These are found on page 408 of the Journal.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: That was replaced by this one committee amendment.

CLERK: I'm at a loss as to which one goes.....

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Let me....I'll come and show you which one I have.

PRESIDENT: Stand by just a moment. Senator Savage.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Can I have unanimous consent to be excused the rest of the day?
