SENATOR WARNER: Could I inquire of the Clerk, is the amendment up there that I signed this morning? I don't know if it got turned in, it's a corrected committee amendment.

CLERK: There appears to be a corrected committee amendment.

SENATOR WARNER: Two page?

CLERK: Yes.

SENATOR WARNER: Okay.

CLERK: There are a series of other amendments too.

SENATOR WARNER: All right. I would move to strike the committee amendment that was adopted Friday in lieu of this one. The, I believe, the only differences are two things. One, the name is changed....back to Eastern which is the way the amendment came out of committee. There was additional language put in because of the change of name. It was down in bill drafting that it was done. I was aware of it but I didn't attach significance to it. That was that both the Omaha board and Eastern board would act as an interim board until a new board was appointed by the Governor. The committee amendment would just make the Eastern board the acting board until the new board was appointed. I would move the adoption of this amendment in lieu of the committee amendment that was adopted on last Friday.

PRESIDENT: Stand by just a minute. Senator Warner, the Chair would observe that we really need a motion and I think you said it, but I really want to make sure that the Body heard it. That we strike the committee amendment, excuse me, strike the amendment.....
