PRESIDENT: Does that include the notices?

CLERK: That's all, Mr. President, right.

PRESIDENT: Are there any notices of committee hearings?

CLERK: No further ones, no.

PRESIDENT: Are we ready for final reading?

CLERK: Yes.

PRESIDENT: Will the senators please take their seats. We'll be ready for final reading. We're ready for final reading.

PRESIDENT: I'm going to start calling names. Senator Schmit, please take your seat. Senator Carstens, please take your seat. Senator Fellman, please take your seat. Rules of the Legislature require that we be in our seats on final reading. Will the Sergeant at Arms please go and take Senator Schmit and escort him to his seat. Mr. Clerk, we're ready for final reading. LB640.

CLERK: Read LB640.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is shall the bill pass. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: Read vote. 34 ayes, 9 nays, 6 not voting.

PRESIDENT: LB640 passes. The next bill is LB684.

CLERK: LB684.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is shall the bill pass. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: Read vote. 39 ayes, 5 nays, 5 not voting.

PRESIDENT: LB684 passes.

CLERK: That's all, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Are there any Resolutions, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: None.

PRESIDENT: Are there any bills to be introduced?

CLERK: LB223A introduced by Senator Kennedy. Read LB223A.

PRESIDENT: Senator Kennedy, do you wish to speak on the bill? Any other bills to be introduced? It's an 'A' bill which goes in automatically. Select File. The Chair recognizes Senator Cavanaugh. We're on Select File. Senator Cavanaugh, while you're getting ready, the Chair will recognize Senator Fellman. For what reason do you wish to speak?
