SENATOR MARESH: Senator Kremer, I wonder since we're faced with this threat of losing federal funds I wonder if a resolution would be in order to ask if the highway department started placing these signs at the present time by resolution that the Legislature would direct them to start replacing these signs so they would be in place by the deadline?

SENATOR KREMER: In answer to your question, Senator Maresh, I doubt if the resolution would be necessary. I conferred with the department, they are all ready to go, and I was informed that if we pass the law that we will not be in danger of losing any funds, that approvals of projects will be made and they're all ready to go.
