PRESIDENT: Any discussion. Senator Carpenter. Ready to move the bill. Those in favor of advancing LB 734 vote aye, those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Senator Whitney voting aye. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The bill advances. The next bill is LB 735.

Clerk will read the title.

CLERK: LB 735 (read) There are committee amendments by Senator Luedtke, Judiciary Committee.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes, Senator Luedtke.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: I move the adoption of the committee amendments. Mr. President. Mr. President and members of the Legislature, the committee amendments merely carry out the intent of the bill itself to the particularly with section 2, Section 29812 of the statutes, which adds four associate county judge with regard to authorization of search warrant, which comes up at any time at any place. And the flexibility of the associate judge the way we are using them now, requires that this be done in order to give smaller communities of Nebraska this kind of service.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion? I have a voice vote. Those in favor of the committee amendment say aye, those opposed say no. Committee amendment is adopted. Senator Luedtke.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Mr. President, I move that LB 735 as amended be advanced to E & R for Review. The basic thrust of LB 735 is to permit the associate county judges to serve in additional counties thus making even more flexible, the appointment of associate judges, the employment of associate judges, and their juse from county to county depending upon this where the work load is, and the court administrator has been watching this very carefully, and if we are going to make this system as efficient as it should be this particular bill will help do it.

PRESIDENT: The question has been called for. Those in favor of advancing LB 735 vote aye, those opposed vote no. Senator Whitney voting aye.

CLERK: Mr. President, the machine is malfunctioning. I will have to clear it and get ...
