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administrator who has analyzed the entire matter of fees collected by county courts and has come to the conclusion with the court that these fees should be increased. Most county judges throughout the state have said this for a long time and there was no opposition to the bill when it was heard. So, I would move the adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT: Any discussion? We'll take a voice vote. Those in favor of adopting the committee amendments, say aye. Opposed say no. The committee amendments are adopted. Senator Luedtke.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Now, as I stated, the basic part of this bill raises the fees for civil matters in county court. In other words, those who bring action should pay for them and this is the increase as you will note for the civil actions are noted within the bill itself. They're increased from, if you will note, on page 2, the county courts will be entitled to the following fees and then the, for orders after judgment including writs the \$300 is stricken and the amount of the increase is inserted.

PRESIDENT: Any discussion? Have you moved the bill?

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Yes, I'll be sending it in as amended, be advanced to E & R initial.

PRESIDENT: It's been moved that LB739 be advanced to E & R Review as amended. Those in favor, vote aye. Those opposed, vote nay. Senator Whitney voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Whitney voting aye.

PRESIDENT: We are voting on LB739. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, no nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB739 is advanced. Next bill is LB742.

CLERK: Read LB742.

PRESIDENT: Senator Luedtke.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: I move that LB742 be advanced to E & R initial. And, in the next series of bills, I'm going to call upon Senator Schmit whose interest in the field of drug control legislation has been very great and who brought this series of bills to the attention of the Judiciary Committee. They are through the help of the Patrol and the attorneys on the Patrol which the Legislature gave the Patrol the last session. These series of bills were developed in the Judiciary Committee, voted them out onto General File. I would ask that, Senator Schmit, if you would take them up, beginning with LB742, to just summarize what the individual bills are.

PRESIDENT: Will Senator Schmit care to speak?

SENATOR SCHMIT: Well, Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislature, Senator Luedtke has explained LB742. I move the bill be moved or advanced to E & R.

PRESIDENT: Senator Cavanaugh.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Well, I'd have some questions as to exactly what these substances are that we're adding here. Do you know?
