

PRESIDENT: Senator Goodrich can you handle the DeCamp amendment?

CLERK: Read LB815.

SENATOR GOODRICH: I can handle those if you want me too.

PRESIDENT: OK, Senator Goodrich.

SENATOR GOODRICH: OK, on the Committee Amendments they were adopted by the committee as a result of a conference among about a dozen attorneys and they got together and adopted these amendments. I concur in the amendments that they do nothing but straighten out the mechanical problems of the bill. I would move the adoption of the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT: Mr. Clerk....Senator Moylan.

SENATOR MOYLAN: I would move that we pass over this bill. It is highly important and I think that everybody in here ought to hear it.

PRESIDENT: Pass over the bill. Next bill is 870.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Mr. President, I move that we pass over 870 and 825.

PRESIDENT: Next bill is 924.

CLERK: Read LB924

PRESIDENT: Read the amendment by Senator Carpenter.

CLERK: Read amendment.

PRESIDENT: Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: (inaudible)

PRESIDENT: Senator Carpenter has asked for unanimous consent to withdraw his amendment, are there any objections? If not the amendment is withdrawn. Senator Duis,

SENATOR DUIS: I merely would like to ask if you might want to pass over this bill, or do you wish to take it up? Ok the appropriations in the appropriations bill, so that...yeah the additional, alright.

PRESIDENT: Senator Burbach, do you wish to be heard?

SENATOR BURBACH: Is it time to explain the bill?

PRESIDENT: Yes.

SENATOR BURBACH: I move to advance, I ask unanimous consent to advance 924 to E & R Initial. The purpose of this is to create a special fund known as the Nebraska Emergency Trust Fund. When it is fully funded it calls for a million and a half dollars by 1979. The interest accrued at any time stays within this fund and it stays there when money is withdrawn for emergencies it then should be replaced and kept at at a annual or at a static figure of a million and a half dollars after each legislative session. I ask unanimous consent for the advance of 924 to E & R Initial.
