SENATOR CARPENTER: Now, Mr. President....

PRESIDENT: Yes, sir.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I will go over and talk to Senator Keyes and answer any questions he asks, if I can.

PRESIDENT: Thank you.

SENATOR KEYES: That don't put the Lieutenant Governor in good light with me one bit.

PRESIDENT: Do we have anything to do with LB763? (Malfunction)

SENATOR STULL: LB763 be adopted.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to adopt the amendments to LB763. All those in favor of adopting amendments please say aye. Those opposed say no. So ordered, the amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Now, Mr. President, there are a series of amendments to LB763 by Senator Richendifer and then there's a request by Senator Richendifer to bracket the bill. Do you want to adopt the amendments or bracket it?

PRESIDENT: Stand by. He has an amendment we want to take up or are we going to bracket it first? All right, now the motion is to bracket LB763 on Select File. Are there objections to bracketing the bill there? Any objections to bracketing the bill on Select File? Hearing none, so ordered, bracket it.

SENATOR STULL: I move the amendments to LB647 be adopted.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to adopt the amendments to LB647. All those in favor of adopting the amendments please say aye. Those opposed say no. Amendments are adopted.

SENATOR STULL: Now, I move that LB647 as amended be advanced to E & R for Engrossing.

PRESIDENT: The motion now is to advance LB647. Senator Kelly.

SENATOR KELLY: Mr. President, I'd like to ask Senator Carpenter some questions on LB647.

PRESIDENT: All right, stand by. Senator Carpenter. Senator Carpenter, you can stand there and speak if you like but Senator Kelly wants to ask you a couple of questions about LB647, which we have now adopted E & R amendments to LB647. We're ready to move it off of Select File. Do you yield to a question?

SENATOR CARPENTER: Yes, I yield.

PRESIDENT: LB647. Let him find the bill there, Senator Kelly.

SENATOR CARPENTER: This is a bill that was amended.

PRESIDENT: Wait a minute. What was your question, Senator Kelly?

SENATOR KELLY: It appears to me, Senator Carpenter, that we're taking all of these duties of the court reporters and the whole bit away from the district judges.....
