CLERK: Read amendment.

PRESIDENT: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move adoption of the amendment. I think it has probably been adequately discussed. Again at that level it will permit equalization of the fully funded and returned will provide more money will be able to go out on per pupil basis which I suspect will be more beneficial to the schools that some of you have pointed out that you probably realize it still will accomplish the over all purpose of equalization together with the over all purpose of mill levy reductions. Also I wish to say, Mr. President, that it would be my understanding that the bill would be bracketed on Final Reading after it has been reproduced so you could all see exactly how it is and have every question you may want cleared up answered.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion? Are you ready for the question? The question is, shall the Warner amendment be adopted. This requires 25 votes. All those in favor vote aye. Those opposed vote no.

Mr. President, your committee on Public Health to whom was referred LB930 instructs me to report the same to General File as amended. LB1020 General File, signed, Senator Kennedy, Chairman. Mr. Chairman, Senator Marvel asked to be excused for the balance of the morning.
