

There was no opposition to this bill, I move that this bill be advanced from General File to E & R Initial.

PRESIDENT: Is there any further discussion of LB881? Any further discussion? Question is shall LB881 be advanced from General File to E & R Initial. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. You are voting on the advancement of LB881 from General File to E & R Initial. For those that have just arrived, after 3:30, depending upon the order in which they are received at the desk, we will take up a bill from any Senator that is considered non-controversial in the order of which they are received. LB881 is looking for 25 votes to advance from General File. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Bill is advanced. That brings us up to LB882 for General File consideration. The Clerk will read the bill.

CLERK: Read LB882.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Maresh.

SENATOR MARESH: Mr. President, this is another bill that was presented to the committee by Judge Novicoff to clarify how the...this is to create an appropriation formula for determining how the 75% of the weekly wage benefits shall be distributed. If the children live with the widow or widower the spouse shall receive 60% and the Children 15%. If there is a child not living at home then the rate is 55% to the spouse and 20% for the children. At the hearing there was no opposition. The only one that appeared was Judge Novicoff. I move that the bill be advanced from General File to E & R Initial.

PRESIDENT: Is there need for further discussion of the bill? Then the question is shall LB882 be advanced from General File to E & R Initial. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. LB882 is looking for 25 votes to advance from General File. You are voting on the advancement of LB882 from General File. Well Senator Maresh, what is your pleasure? Well somebody push his button then, we have to record it. Thank you, Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays and 24 not voting.

PRESIDENT: Bill is advanced then. Alright between now and 3:30 it would be the Chair's understanding Senator Barnett that we go back to the list which we received and we begin with LB682. (someones mike not activated, can not hear statement). President, from what? That is what the list was and we were to take up this list and begin at that particular point at the list, unless we had further instructions. Until 3:30 that is what we will work on. CLERK: Mr. President, there is a request to bracket LB1015, 953, and 957 and 961, signed, Senator Fellman.

PRESIDENT: Are there objections to bracketing the bills? Hearing none, so ordered. Senator Barnett.
