

continue right on, aren't we?

PRESIDENT: We will continue on what?

SENATOR BARNETT: Right on our dally worksheet. Are we going to just keep right on a going?

PRESIDENT: The instructions that the Chair last received was that we were going to begin with LB983 and on this sheet and I think that you made the motion, right?

SENATOR BARNETT: Yeah, go ahead what else did I say?

PRESIDENT: Then at 3:30 we are going to take up.....

SENATOR BARNETT: I didn't say anything about 3:30.

PRESIDENT: The Chair didn't have any instructions beyond the sheet, I don't think.

SENATOR BARNETT: I thought that we were going by the worksheet what we have been doing for three days, I'm sorry.

PRESIDENT: You want to go on down the worksheet then?

SENATOR BARNETT: Yes.

PRESIDENT: Alright, are there objections to continue on down the worksheet then? After LB882? Hearing none, so ordered. We will go to the worksheet then. That brings up for General File debate LB897. Senator Maresh, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR MARESH: Mr. President, I would like to pass this bill over, I don't have all of the information here.

PRESIDENT: Alright, LB897...brings up for general file consideration 951.

CLERK: Read LB951

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Fellman.

SENATOR FELLMAN: Mr. President, this is a bill that merely follows a decision of the Supreme Court last year, which required labor unions to file a special way of registration certificate. There was no books in the Supreme Court in the Secretary of State's office to file this and no way to do this and this exempts all in-state associations from the requirements because they maintain a place of business and it allows them to be served in case of a law suit at that place of business. It requires out-of-state associations or unions to register with the Secretary of State. I move the bill be advanced.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion of the bill? Then the question is shall LB951 be advanced from General File to E & R Initial. All those in favor of the advancement of the bill will vote aye, those opposed will vote no. You are voting on the advancement of LB951 from General File. Senator Fellman is looking for 25 votes for his LB951. Have you all voted? Once again have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays
