CLERK: Now Mr. President, Senator Duis has an amendment to strike the Emergency Clause.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: I'm merely trying to fix this so that it won't come into effect upon signing of it and I think that it is perfectly alright with Senator Cavanaugh and everyone else concerned so that there would be sufficient time in order to prepare for it.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion of the Duis amendment then to 710? Senator Cavanaugh, are you in agreement? Question is shall the Duis amendment be adopted? All those in favor say aye, those opposed say no. So ordered. The amendment is adopted. Now then, are there other amendments to the bill?

CLERK: None.

PRESIDENT: Very good, Senator Cavanaugh, back to you.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: I move that LB710 be advanced to E & R Initial.

PRESIDENT: Is there need for further discussion of the bill? Then the question is shall LB710 as amended be advanced from General File to E & R Initial. All those in favor of advancing the bill vote aye, those opposed vote no. While we are waiting for 25 votes the next order of business will be LB812, 960, 682, 710, oops, 710 we are off. We are voting on the advancement of 710 from General File. That is not fair Senator Cavanaugh to double team me that way. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Alright, 710 is advanced. We will now go to the general file consideration of LB812, Senator Chambers bill. If you want to make a list of them I'll try and give them to you as I have them up here. Are you listening? OK, 812. 710 is advanced. We now go to 812, 960, 682. This is a 3:20 yes, this is not a 3:30 order. OK, 104. Where is a it at? Wait a minute Senator Syas, I have to find it. No fair, this is tough enough. Alright, We are looking at LB812.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Wait a minute we have to have the bill read first Senator Chambers. Clerk will read 812.
