

CLERK: Read LB812

PRESIDENT: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the legislature all this bill does is to make it possible for the state department of education to receive and act on complaints that may be filed against people who are running modeling schools and it makes it possible for the department of education to set standards for modeling schools like it does trade schools and other schools. Rather than to try and write a bill dealing specifically with modelling schools I thought that it would be best to leave it with the department that does this kind of work anyway. They have the knowledge and they can draw broader regulations that would be fair to everybody. There are no committee amendments so I move that the bill be advanced to E & R Initial.

PRESIDENT: Is there need for further discussion of LB812? Then the question is shall 812 be advanced from general file to E & R initial. All those in favor of advancing the bill vote aye, those opposed vote no. You are voting on the advancement of Senator Chambers 812. It is the suspense that kills us. You are voting on the advancement of LB812 from General File to E & R Initial. A motion which still requires 25 votes. Once again the chair would inquire have you all voted? Thank you. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. That brings up SENator Goodrich's bill LB960.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Mr. President members of the body.

PRESIDENT: Stand by Senator Goodrich till we read it.

CLERK: Read LB960

PRESIDENT: Senator Goodrich.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Mr. President, the committee amendments were adopted the other day.

CLERK: Not according to my record.

SENATOR GOODRICH: OK, I move the adoption of the committee amendments. The committee amendments do nothing but restate the one paragraph bill and we took the bill into Senator or a...a...Emory Burnett's office and he reworded the language and also put in a piece or two to the effect that the party that has done the work on the merchandise if there is a lein on it he would have to notify him also. I move the adoption of the committee amendment.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion of the committee amendment? Then the question is do you want to adopt the committee amendments? Those in favor say aye, those opposed say no. Amendments are adopted. Are there other amendments to the bill? Alright Senator Goodrich back to you as amended.
