

PRESIDENT: That brings up for general file discussion LB821 Senator Dickinson's bill. Then 625 Senator Kime's bill and then 679, Senator Barnett's bill.

CLERK: Read LB821.

PRESIDENT: Alright, the Chair recognizes Senator Kremer.

SENATOR KREMER: Mr. Chairman, members of the Legislature, these provisions came from the department of motor vehicles and it does make the bill workable. I will try and explain them to you. The ones that are of importance. Number one, they change the provision of registration can not be made unless the tax is paid the year previous so since it is going to be on a staggered basis you can't refer to it as a year previous. It changes the calendar year, the word-age calendar year to a registration period. That is necessary. Now the changes the next provision in the amendments is actually a bill and it changes the renewal of the plates for the first year a one year after the date of issuance. Rather than on January the 1st, that is the year from the date of issuance and becomes a month delinquent following that. Also the amendments also provide that it does not apply to Delears licenses, it strikes the language on page 11 and 12, I believe that would not make the bill workable and number 6, it refers to commercial trucks and now the statute provides that commercial trucks can be paid, the license can be paid only half a year at a time so it proves that July 1st now it says the seventh month. The year to periods. I move for the adoption of the new committee amendments.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the committee amendments to LB821? Then the question is shall the amendments be adopted, all those in favor please say aye, those opposed say no. Amendments are adopted. Are there other committee amendments or any amendments to the bill?

CLERK: None.

PRESIDENT: Alright thank you. Senator Dickinson back to you.

SENATOR DICKINSON: Mr. President, members of the legislature, this bill has been considered and argued for some time. This year it was discussed by county officials and particularly county treasurers. It is a compromise bill. They agreed upon it. There is no opposition to the bill and it will facilitate issuing automobile registrations and licenses in particularly populous counties and it will also help the motor vehicle department here in the state house to keep a better set of records in compliance with a federal government in checking for all sorts of things that they check through auto records and registrations. It will stagger the registration on a date of...we will get transferred over to it on the basis of when we change vehicles. It will take probably four years to make almost a complete change. We trade autos or buy one that is the date that you register it and you will register one day thereafter from then on. That is basically what the bill does, I move for its advancement to E & R Initial.

PRESIDENT: Is there need for further discussion of the bill? Alright then the question is shall LB821 as amended be advanced from General File to E & R Initial. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. You are voting on the advancement
