

as I understand it now we are not going to request revenue projections from both the Governor and the fiscal staff and with Senator Carpenter's suggestion as long as it doesn't interfere with the fiscal staff's budget responsibilities so that it would delay putting the budget bill out on the floor, so, when we a...a...when can we anticipate the budget bill being out and when can we anticipate the fiscal projections, how much interference is there going to be?

PRESIDENT: Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: The only response that I can make is that as far as the recommendations of the committee are supposed to be out this week. That is the only answer that I can give. On Senator Lewis' motion, I assume that he knows what he wants and I assume that he knows how long it will take let him answer the question, I can't answer that portion of it.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Senator Marvel you do direct the fiscal staff, do you expect that there providing us with revenue projections will interfere will providing us with...

SENATOR MARVEL: It will interfere somewhat, I still would be optimistic that all of us or that all of this could be done by the end of the week.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Could I suggest that we require the staff to provide us with that information by Friday. I'll make that motion. I move to amend the motion that it be provided by Friday.

PRESIDENT: Well this is a far ranging and loose amendment. Excuse, me motion to begin with. I would accept that what Senator Cavanaugh is going to ask for as an amendment to the original motion and actually we have.....Senator Marvel do you care to respond.

SENATOR MARVEL: I think that that last request is in direct conflict with what Senator Carpenter amendment indicated. This would be done without any disturbance of getting the budget bill out on the floor. Now you can't have your cake and eat it too. I thought that we had agreed that the first thing would be done would be to get the budget bill out and then the a staff after this is accomplished would get up this other. Now if you are going to insist that it be done by Friday, then in effect you are affecting or could possibly effect the intent of the motion. I think that yours is a separate motion Senator Cavanaugh.

PRESIDENT: The Chair would so rule Senator Cavanaugh as a matter of fact.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: I haven't made a motion to elicit that response. I was wondering if there was a conflict or not, Senator Marvel seemed to indicate in his first answer that there would not be and that they could do both a so I thought that I would suggest the time limit to see if they could do both. Now apparently they can't and I think that we should have some idea as to when we are going to be able to consider this thing. If they can't get a revenue for three weeks we ought to know that because it doesn't do us any good to have the budget done.
