PRESIDENT: Now you have heard the motion to adopt the amendments to 694. All those in favor of the motion say aye, those opposed say no. The amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Motion on the desk, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Read the motion on the desk.

CLERK: We have an amendment to LB 694, page 4, line 1, strike 60 and reinsert three hundred. (Signed) Senator Fowler.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Fowler.

SENATOR FOWLER: The amendment is very simple. It is to restore the bill to it's original form. It was an amendment on General File that expanded the thing from Douglas County to include Sarpy and Lancaster Counties. Those of us in the Lancaster County delegation said that we would not oppose that then, we would let the bill go ahead and try to get some response on it. I have talked to some individuals concerned about the Weed Control Authority, and feel that this removal of notice would be unhealthy for Lancaster County. So we would like to restore the bill back to it's original form.

PRESIDENT: Is there a need for further discussion of the motion. Then the question is, shall the amendment be adopted to 694 as proposed by Senator Fowler. If you are in favor vote aye. If you are opposed vote no. You are voting on a amendment on to 694 on Select File as proposed by Senator Fowler. A motion that still requires 25 votes. Senator Fowler is looking for 25 votes for an amendment to 694 on Select File. Have you all voted?

SENATOR FOWLER: I hate to have to call for a Call of the House for one vote.

PRESIDENT: It's pretty early for that, thank you. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, no nays, 24 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted. Are there other amendments to the bill.

CLERK: None, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: All right. Thank you. Senator Cavanaugh.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: I move that LB8..What is it..694 be advanced to E & R for Engrossing.

PRESIDENT: The motion now is to advance LB694 as amended. All those in favor of the advancement of the bill please say aye. Those opposed say no. The bill is advanced.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB911.

PRESIDENT: The motion to adopt the amendments to 911. All those in favor of the adoption of the amendments please say aye. Those opposed say no. The amendments are adopted.

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
