CLERK: 30 ayes, 18 nays and 1 not voting.

PRESIDENT: LB77 is passed not withstanding the objection of the Governor.

CLERK: Motion on the desk Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Read the motion on the desk.

CLERK: I move to override the Governor's veto on LB77A.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: I move that we vote Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the motion? Question is shall LB77A be passed not withstanding the objection of the Governor. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Question is shall LB77A be passed not withstanding the objection of the Governor? Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I ask for a roll call vote again, otherwise this bill is no good at all.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carpenter asking for a roll call vote. Question is shall LB77A be passed not withstanding the objection of the Governor. Clerk will clear the board. Question is shall LB77A not withstanding the objection of the Governor? Roll call vote.

CLERK: Roll call vote. 30 ayes, 18 nays and 1 not voting. Vote appears on page 933 of the Legislative Journal.

PRESIDENT: LB77A is passed not withstanding the objection of the Governor. Senator Schmit.
