PRESIDENT: Senator Nore, please sit down, you're under a Call of the House.

CLERK: Senator Burbach voting nay.

PRESIDENT: Senator Burbach voting nay.

CLERK: Senator Marvel voting nay.

PRESIDENT: Senator Marvel voting nay. Senator Kelly voting no.

CLERK: Senator Kelly voting nay.

PRESIDENT: Senator Fellman voting no.

CLERK: Senator Fellman voting nay.

PRESIDENT: Senator Lewis...Richard Lewis, did I see you beckon back there? Thank you, sir. Senator Stahmer, we're under a Call of the House. Please take your seat. Senator Goodrich, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR GOODRICH: I move the Call be raised.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to raise the Call. All those in favor of raising the Call, please vote aye. All those opposed vote no. Thank you, Clerk will record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 2 nays to raise the Call.

PRESIDENT: Call is raised. Read the tally of the original issue.

CLERK: 17 ayes, 25 nays, the remainder not voting.

PRESIDENT: All right, the motion is lost. Now, are there other amendments to LB984?

CLERK: Yes, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: All right, let's go to those. Stand by, Senator Warner.

CLERK: Mr. President, we have a motion from Senator Warner to strike the last two paragraphs of the Warner amendment on page 800 of the Journal. These amendments were adopted yesterday and today wants to strike them.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, if I can have the attention of the members. An error...a simple error was made. The amendments that appeared on page 800 of the Journal contained two amendments on two different sheets and the assumption, I guess, was made that both of them were adopted. What I'm proposing to strike was the amendment that I had filed with the Clerk that appropriated the \$20 million that was re-appropriated last year. It's already in the budget bill, it should not have been adopted. It was my intention to withdraw that amendment or not to take it up and I wasn't aware until just a few minutes ago that it was among...it was included as adopted because it appeared on page 800 along with the one that was. So, Mr. President, I just request that that be stricken because it should not have been a part of the bill.
