

will be covered by a personnel board that will be picked up and appointed by the county officials the elected officials and the employees. All three will have a hand in the personnel board. The rules and the regulations that the county will adopt, the personnel board will go through these people through the county employees and to the elected officials. I think that what we would like to do is to move this bill on and if there is any serious disagreement we would be happy to have the amendments added on or suggested or discussed on select file. If there are any questions I would be more than happy to try and answer them, but I think that the Lancaster County delegation is in agreement that this bill should be advanced off of general file to E & R initial and therefore I would ask for the adoption of the committee amendments at this time.

PRESIDENT: Adoption of the committee amendments. All in favor say aye, those opposed say no. Opposed? Committee amendments are adopted. Senator Barnett what do you want to do with the bill?

SENATOR BARNETT: Mr. President, I would move that LB995 be advanced to E & R Initial as amended.

PRESIDENT: It has been moved that LB995 be advanced to Initial. Questions? 25 votes. We need 25 votes.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays and 18 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill has been advanced. Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Senator Burbach has a bill 826A which he had to answer the phone, I move that we consider that. We have already passed the other bill we might just as well pass the A bill with it.

PRESIDENT: Any objections to Senator Carpenter's request? If not, where is Senator Burbach?

SENATOR CARPENTER: I move that it be advanced to E & R for Initial.

PRESIDENT: Read the title.

CLERK: Read LB826A.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I move the bill be advanced to E & R Initial.

PRESIDENT: It has been moved and seconded that the bill be advanced. Question. Have you all voted? Tabulate the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays 23 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I move that we adjourn until 9:00 a.m.

PRESIDENT: It has been moved and seconded. Any committee reports?
