

PRESIDENT: Senator Murphy.

SENATOR MURPHY: Mr. President, I move that the numbers be inserted in the aforementioned paragraphs 304, 5 and 6 to bring the total act into conformity.

PRESIDENT: Any discussion? Those in favor say aye, those opposed say no. Amendments are adopted. It takes 25 votes to adopt that, those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, and 22 not voting.

PRESIDENT: Are you ready to move the bill?

SENATOR MURPHY: I move the bill be advanced to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT: Now it takes 25 votes to readvance. Do you have a question Senator Carpenter? Those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote nay to advance the bill. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays and 23 not voting.

PRESIDENT: LB327 is advanced. Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I ask unanimous consent to unbracket 616 on Select File.

PRESIDENT: Unanimous consent motion to unbracket 616. Any objections? Senator Goodrich.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Would Senator Carpenter yield to a question please? Senator Proud wanted to have some input in this particular bill, would you object to waiting until he got back?

SENATOR CARPENTER: Yes.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Then I would object to unbracket it.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I move the question. This bill Mr. President has been hanging here and we moved it for one day and we have had the bill put on everybody's desk and I think that now is the time to move it one way or the other. I ask to move the question in order to unbracket 616 with the attempt to move it from Select File to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to unbracket LB616 on Select File. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed....wait a minute, Senator C. Carsten has a....

SENATOR CARSTEN: No, not on this Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: OK, those in favor vote aye and those opposed vote nay. We are voting on the unbracketing of LB616.
