

CLERK: Motion on the desk Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Read the motion.

CLERK: Read motion regarding LB629.

PRESIDENT: Senator Keyes.

SENATOR KEYES: Mr. President, I move for the adoption of the amendment. This just puts...this does exactly what Senator Duis was concerned about the other day, so I would move for the adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT: This is on Select File so it will take 25 votes. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote nay. Please pay attention to voting. Just a correction error on LB629. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.
