

PRESIDENT: Is there any further discussion of Senator Barnett's motion which is to reject the committee amendments and then it is the Chair's understanding that he has substitute amendments. If you reject the committee amendments to LB622 as suggested by Senator Barnett, please say aye, those opposed say no. So ordered. The amendments are objected.

CLERK: Read Richendifer amendment.

PRESIDENT: Senator Richendifer.

SENATOR RICHENDIFER: Mr. President, members of the Legislature I move for the adoption of the amendment. This amendment is a compromise on the bill. It is going to be very simple that I can read to you what the bill will be like, after the adoption of these amendments. The Governor shall appoint a state fire marshall with the consent of the legislature. Who shall under the general direction and supervision of the Governor perform the duties and exercise the powers and have the rights and privileges and so forth and the rest of that new matter there. Then in section four and that would be the bill. This is a compromise, and I think that Senator Barnett has talked to the firemen and they have agreed to this, so I somove.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the Richendifer amendment? Are you all through discussing it? Senator Whitney, your light is on and I'm wondering if you want to discuss something, Senator Dickinson yours is on too, do you want to discuss this amendment? Thank you. When Senator Mahoney comes back we can catch his. You don't want to discuss the Richendifer amendment here do you? Alright any further discussion of the Richendifer amendment to 622? All those in favor of the amendment say aye, those opposed say no. So ordered, the amendment is adopted. Are there other amendments? Senator Barnett.

SENATOR BARNETT: I move that LB622 be advanced as amended. I think that Senator Richendifer has told you what it does. It sets up the Fire Marshall's office as a separate agency for the first time and it makes the fire marshall subject to confirmation by the legislature and this is agreeable to everybody concerned at this time, so I move for the bill.

PRESIDENT: Once again are you all through discussing the bill as amended? The question is, shall LB622 as amended be advanced from General File to E & R Initial. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? That motion still takes 25 votes. Have you all voted? Thank you, Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Very good, bill is advanced. Now is it the Chair's understanding that we do have a list of bills to go by?

CLERK: Yes sir.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Lets take a look at 876 first of all, Senator Warner's bill.
