The title page is incorrect and then Emory has has drafted an amendment to 897 to correct the title page. 32-522 provides the method of appointing a Governor or Lt. Governor by the proper committee of the same political party in the event of a vacancy in any or one or both offices after the primary election. 19-605 provides a method for a city of the first class to adopt a resolution providing for the submitting of the question of organizing a manager form of government. New section provides a method for a first class city having a city manager form of government to abandon the city manager form of government. 19-3004 removes an obsolete section of the statutes. 19-3005 removes a conflict in dates for notice of election and the filing deadline when the cities or villages hold their elections on the first Tuesday of April. New section provides for a candidate who has withdrawn or because of death has filed has a filing fee reimbursed. The Secretary of State felt that this should be a provision that if somebody dies or wishes to withdraw that his filing fee would be repaid. We also would like to add the emergency clause to LB897. I move that the General File amendments be adopted.

SENATOR WARNER: Yes, first I would like to ask Senator Maresh a question and then talk or depend upon what your answer is. Senator Maresh, on page 5 of your amendment at the bottom where it talks about a vacancy on Governor or Lt. Governor

race, the last language relative to a vacancy on the ballot for Governor indicate that the political party would be prohibited from having the Lt. Governor nominee being made the Governor's nominee for the Governor for that party. Why would you prohibit the person nominated for Lt. Governor to become eligible to then be the Governor's candidate when if after election he could become Governor.

SENATOR MARESH: All I know is that this is a recommendation of the Secretary of State Senator Warner, and if you wish to amend the amendment, I guess that this is the proper time to do it.

SENATOR WARNER: It seems highly illogical when I offer the amendment, I am wondering if there is some reason to prohibit the nominee for Lt. Governor to be named the Governor's candidate or the candidate for Governor. Because of...is there some mechanical reason in the election process or something. You are not aware of any reason?

SENATOR MARESH: No, I don't. I think that this is his recommendation....

SENATOR WARNER: For the moment, Mr. President, I move that on page 5 following the word vacated, in line 25 in place of period somebody writing it Beth? Strike line 26, 27, on page 5 and strike line 1 and 2 on page 6. I don't have it written out but I will. I'll offer to reinsert Senator Maresh on Select File if there is a reason for it, but it seems very illogical.
