Attention please, Senator Warner is now closing.

SENATOR WARNER: Well, only this Mr. President. Senator Proud you are one of the type hunters that worry me, and that is the poor shot. That's the one that's going to be out hitting something other than the birds, and we've got a lot of those around, around our part of the area, apparently. I am amazed that Senator Anderson, argument, that we ought to legalize it, because it is being done. Now if you start to apply that same argument to drugs or a whole lot of other things, Senator Anderson, it appears almost ridiculous for one to suggest. Secondly, the roads...to I believe that one of you mentioned that you were opposed to people driving around hunting that way, and some or how or other this was going to be different. I'd suggest to you all this bill will do is to lead to more driving around looking for birds and they won't necessarily be in the ditch I can assure you, they will be anywhere close to it and they will say, well the bird just flew up out of the ditch and I happened to shoot him out over the field, and it will be immaterial what was out there, I would hope that the body would realize that if I could speak rather firmly for the area I come from. But this will add to the deterioration of the farmer hunter relationships and there isn't any question in my mind that if you feel that we do not have adequate open area now, you are going to find much less, hunting area available, because every farmer for his own protection, and the lives of his family probably, and livestock is going to end up posting everything he's got, because it's the only way he can, including no trespassing signs, that's the only way we have to protect the things that we want to protect.

PRESIDENT: Now the question is, shall LB779 then be returned from Final Reading to Select File for specific amendment, that be to strike the enacting clause. You are voting now only to return the bill. Do you understand that. You are voting only to return the bill. If you want to return the bill to Select File for the Specific Amendment, vot aye, if not vote no. This is the motion to return 779 to Select File for specific amendment, but it is to return the bill only. Question is shall 779 be returned to Select File. Once again, have you all voted? Clerk will record.
