PRESIDENT: Senator Warner. Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Changed my vote from aye to nay for purposes of reconsideration tomorrow.

PRESIDENT: All right.

CLERK: From no to aye. You voted nay.

SENATOR WARNER: Do I have to not vote aye. To reconsider.

CLERK: Changing from no to aye.

SENATOR WARNER: For purposes of reconsideration in the morning.

CLERK: Voting aye 30, voting nay 13, not voting 6.

CLERK: LB784 (read)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, 'Shall the bill pass.' All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Voting on the final passage of LB784. Once again the chair would inquire Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: Voting aye 39, voting 9, not voting 10 (Printed on page 1037-38 Journal)

PRESIDENT: Did you want to vote Senator Dickinson? All right, Senator Dickinson voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Dickinson voting aye.

PRESIDENT: Senator Johnson voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Johnson voting aye.

CLERK: 39 ayes, no nays, 10 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill is passed. Attention please, the final Reading of LB796.

CLERK: LB 796, (read).

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, 'Shall the bill pass?' All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. You are voting on the final passage of LB 796. Please indicate your pleasure. Once again, have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: Voting 39, voting nay 1, not voting 9. (Printed on Page 1038 in Journal.)
