SENATOR CARPENTER: All right, do it. I withdraw all motions I've got pending and I suggest to the Speaker he take care of his duties. Do what he ought to do and set the schedule for us to follow.

SPEAKER PROUD: That is precisely according to the rules and that's what I intend to do and so therefore, as I see it, there is no motion before the Body. You subject or submit your bill to the Clerk and I'll draw up that list and that's the way we're going to take them.

PRESIDENT: All right, then, are there objections to the withdrawal of Senator Carpenter's motion, I hope not. Hearing none, so ordered. The Clerk will clear the board. Senator Carpenter withdraws his motion and we're back to where we were. All right, let's read the reports and we'll go to Select File and just so the Body will be alerted, we will continue with LB877 on Select File. When we get there in just a minute after we read the reports. Clerk will read the reports.

CLERK: Read reports. LB1035 placed on General File. LB951 replaced on Select File as amended. LB660 and LB733 replaced on Select File as amended.

PRESIDENT: Well, what do you know about that? Senator Stull, we're ready...excuse me...Senator Cavanaugh. We're back to Select File beginning with LB877. LB602 is going to come back up again. We've passed over it for the moment. We're trying to move this stuff off...excuse me... these bills off of Select File and take the amendments as they come up in order here beginning with LB877.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: I move the adoption of E & R amendments to LB877.

PRESIDENT: You heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments to LB877. All those in favor of the motion please say aye. Those opposed no. The amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, there's a request now to lay the bill, signed, Senator Warner.

PRESIDENT: Senator Warner. Go ahead, sir.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, just a request to lay it over until tomorrow or the next day. There's an amendment that the bill needs that I haven't gotten yet. I think Senator Fellman has a motion he wants to offer but I assume that can be taken up tomorrow.

PRESIDENT: Stand by, Senator Warner, I didn't have my speaker turned on here and sometimes you're difficult to hear.

SENATOR WARNER: I just indicated I have an amendment which is not as yet here for LB877. I just asked to pass it over until tomorrow so I have it.

PRESIDENT: Senator Warner is asking unanimous consent to just pass over LB877 in preparation for an amendment tomorrow. Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Point of order. When does a bill passed over go to the bottom of General File.
