PRESIDENT: We're on Select File, sir.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I know but I'm asking a question on General File.

PRESIDENT: I believe when it's come up twice with the introducer present twice and he's asked to pass over it twice.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Does the Chair or the Clerk keep track of those things?

CLERK: Yes, we make a note on the bill.

PRESIDENT: He has a note here.

SENATOR CARPENTER: And there...they're automatically on the bottom of General File if that happens.

PRESIDENT: Yes.

CLERK: If the introducer is present.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Now, the motion is to bypass...pass over LB877. Now, are there any objections to passing over LB877 on Select File? Any objections? Hearing none, so ordered then, we'll pass over LB877. Hold it until tomorrow. That moves us on to LB1028, Senator Cavanaugh.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: I move the adoption of E & R amendments to LB1028.

PRESIDENT: You've heard the motion to adopt E & R amendments to LB1028. All those in favor of the motion please say aye. Those opposed say no. The amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, there is now an amendment offered by Senator Carpenter to LB1028.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Carpenter for his amendment to LB1028 on Select File.

SENATOR CARPENTER: This morning I had put on every member's desk a copy of the amendment which includes everything except the emergency clause and the severability clause. Which Senator Schmit wanted to put on the bill and which I incorporated into the one amendment so we don't have to vote on it once. Now this bill was self-explanatory. The bill had been on your desk long enough to have read it. The statement accompanies the bill. It follows out the suggestion of the Body as I understood it in order to bring an amendment to the amendment so it would be clear what the anti-trust laws of the State of Nebraska were and how they might be enforced. And I move for the adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of Senator Carpenter's amendment to LB1028 on Select File. The Chair recognizes Senator Kelly.

SENATOR KELLY: Mr. President and colleagues. I have a question of Senator Carpenter.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carpenter yield?
