SENATOR KELLY: The exemption is \$25. Could you give \$25 every hour? Do we need any time in there as well as amount? If I had a lot of money, could I give you \$25 every hour until I got to a thousand or two thousand, I suppose.

SENATOR FELLMAN: There's another way, there's some other bills, one that would limit the amount of contributions to \$1,000. This wouldn't affect it.

SENATOR KELLY: LB677 would make a...each one identified but in this, I just wanted to bring that out.

SENATOR FELLMAN: I think it..you brought it out.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the amendment? All right then, the question is do you want to adopt the Fellman amendment to LB614 on Select File. Senator Fellman, do you have any closing? All right the question is do you want to adopt the amendment. If so vote aye. If not vote no. All right, read the amendment.

CLERK: The amendment is simply to exempt cash contributions under \$25 from the requirement of the bill. That's all the motion I have, it's not in proper form. It says under \$25.

PRESIDENT: \$25 and under.

CLERK: That's not the amendment for which it was returned.

PRESIDENT: There was some discussion about this this morning and the Chair would agree that I did not hear clear cut \$25 and under but.....

SENATOR FELLMAN: It was my intention \$25 and under so that a \$25 contribution could be made. Otherwise, \$24.99.

PRESIDENT: All right, are there objections to that - \$25 and under? Any objections to that? We'll have to change it then. It's already in the Journal the other way, there will have to be some sort of an amendment made at this particular
