SENATOR SIMPSON: I move to advance LB293 to E & R for Engrossment.

PRESIDENT: You heard the motion now to readvance LB293 as amended. All those in favor of readvancing the bill, please say aye. Those opposed say no. The bill as amended is readvanced.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB602, the Marsh amendment is pending.

PRESIDENT: As amended, the Marsh amendment I believe had one amendment. Was amended this morning. Senator Marsh, what is your pleasure. Excuse me.

CLERK: The E & R amendments have been adopted. The Marsh amendment is pending. There is now a Burbach amendment to the Marsh amendment on page 6, line 9, after "industry" insert "or agricultural purposes". Signed, Senator Burbach.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Burbach.

SENATOR BURBACH: Is the bill on Select File for specific amendment at this time?

PRESIDENT: That's correct, it is on Select File and it is ascending, it has not been called back. It's just open to amendment here.

SENATOR BURBACH: For amendment here.

PRESIDENT: Senator Marsh, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR MARSH: To second Senator Burbach's amendment to my amendment.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Senator Burbach.

SENATOR BURBACH: Well, Mr. President and members of the Legislature. I have been visiting with the introducer, Senator Marsh, about adding these words, this amendment, this act shall not apply to buildings, structures or installations or portions thereof, used for agricultural purposes or heavy industry including but not limited to their repair shops, railroad yards, etc. So I'm adding "agricultural purposes or". I move for the adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT: Is there need to further discuss the amendment? The question is do you adopt the Burbach amendment to the Marsh amendment. If so, vote aye. If not, vote no. Voting on the Burbach amendment to the Marsh amendment LB602. Thank you, Clerk will record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Marsh, what is your pleasure regarding your amendment?

SENATOR MARSH: Please adopt the amendment to LB293 and then let's send it on its way.

PRESIDENT: The question is, shall we adopt the amendment, Marsh amendment as amended. All those in favor of adopting that amendment vote aye. All those opposed vote no. Voting on the Marsh amendment as amended by Senator Burbach to LB602 on Select File. Have you all voted? Thank you. Clerk will record.
