CLERK: They're obviously the latest, they're the second bunch you gave us.

SENATOR RICHENDIFER: Do all they do is change dates?

CLERK: Well, it's a whole paragraph dealing with date.

SENATOR RICHENDIFER: Just change dates? Maybe I'd better look.

PRESIDENT: Senator Richendifer, I'm wondering if you just...

CLERK: Page 682 of your Journal.
